BAAN Court Case 8-9 November 2022

The Court case brought by Bristol Airport Action Network (BAAN) against the Appeal Result which allowed Bristol Airport to expand to 12mppa, was held on 8 and 9 November 2022 at the Bristol Civic Justice Centre in Redcliffe Street, Bristol. There were protests outside which gained media attention. The case was defended by Bristol Airport Ltd and the Department for Levelling up, Housing and Communities. The current chair and vice chair of the PCAA attended some of the sessions and watched others online. It will be several weeks before the result is known.

Noise: Night flights and flight paths -

In October it was reported that a document was being drafted by the PCAA for parishes to put on their web sites to assist people in reporting noise related issues to the airport. The document will be sent to parishes shortly.
