Airport Report 5 September 2023

Local matters - PCAA appointment of new secretary and financial officer. An experienced Parish Clerk has been appointed to take over as secretary of the PCAA starting in October 23.

Bristol Airport plan to remove the Noise Complaints telephone line. BAL say that it is being abused with other complaints being left on it and suggest that people should use the online platform or write a letter. The PCAA have sent a letter strongly objecting to this.

Responses to NSC planning application 23/P/1509/FUL.

The PCAA have commented on the extension to the Main East Terminal. The roof height will marginally exceed that of the existing building. The PCAA have requested that a Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment should be submitted to aid consideration of its impact on the surrounding area prior to determination.

The PCAA are satisfied that the increase in height to the south west corner of the terminal building will not result in any significant impact on distant views of the terminal building

National matters - The AEF report on Raising visibility of those impacted by Airport Noise, finds that nearly ALL airports noise levels exceed WHO recommended levels. Sadly, WHO recommended noise levels are NOT recognised in the UK.
